Small Group Questions

Launch

What's the most fantastical/miraculous thing you've ever witnessed?

Do you think God still works in the miraculous, why or why not? Can you point to any examples?

Observe (READ Acts 5:1-21)

- 1. By way of review from last week, why were Ananias and Sapphira killed?
- 2. What was the effect from their deaths on the rest of the early church according to verse 11?
- 3. What was the extent of the miracles that the apostles were "performing?"

Process

- 1. How might God have used the severity of Ananias and Sapphira to purify the believing community? Where do you see this alluded to in our passage? (Vs.12b-14)
- 2. Were the miracles described in verses 15 and 16 connected to, or independent of, descriptions of those coming to believe in Jesus in verse 14?
- 3. What relationship or connection do you see between the fear of God as a response to Ananias and Sapphira and the miraculous works of the apostles described immediately after?

Respond

In verse 20 the angel gives Peter and the apostles two commands: Go and stand, and tell the people, or "stand firm" and "speak life"

1. Where might Christians need to stand firm today?

- 2. Personally, where is the Holy Spirit convicting you to stand firm this week?
- 3. Where might Christians need to speak life in our time?
- 4. Are there relationship into which the Lord is convicting you to speak life, rather than words of harm, this week?
- 5. Where is repentance needed in one of these areas this week?
- 6. Where can you commit to either one of these (stand firm/speak life) very specifically this week? Don't be afraid to draw one another out away from vague ideas to specific commitments;
 - i.e. This week I am going to apologize to my ______ for harsh words and make an effort to say something encouraging and uplifting at the beginning and end of each day, no matter their response. (This example could be a boss, spouse, or child). What will you commit to?
