Introduction

The power of testimony Big Point: *The boldness of the Holy Spirit will always elevate one message.*

I. Stephen's Profile (Acts 6:8-15)

- A. Full of grace and power (verse 8)
- B. Wisdom of the Holy Spirit (verse 10)
- C. Angelic in likeness (verse 15)
- Apply Do I bear the likeness of Jesus?

II. Stephen's Sermon (Acts 7:2-50)

- A. The Land- was not ultimate (verses 2-34)
- The land was not the center of God's relationship with His people- Jesus is
 - 1. Abraham- God's call came from Mesopotamia (Ur)
 - 2. Joseph and Jacob- God's provision was in Egypt
 - 3. Moses- God's commissioning happened in Midian
 - B. The Law- was not ultimate (verses 35-43)
- The law was not the means to God's relationship with His people- Jesus is
 - 1. Moses spoke beyond the law to a Man (vs.37)
 - 2. Moses prefigured Jesus in His rejection
 - C. The Tabernacle (Temple)- was not ultimate (verses 44-50)
- The temple was not center of God's presence and power for His people- Jesus is
 - 1. The tabernacle anticipated more than the temple
 - 2. The temple was a concession, "David's house."
- Apply What things have I made "ultimate" instead of Christ?

III. Stephen's Warning and Glory (Acts 7:51-60)

A. Warning:

- 1. Stiff-necked- (Exodus 33:5 & Deuteronomy 9:13)
- 2. Hard-hearted- (Leviticus 26:41; Deuteronomy 10:16; Jeremiah 4:4, 9:26)
- 3. Resistant to the Holy Spirit- (Isaiah 63:10 & Zechariah 17:12)
- 4. Receiving but neglecting the Word of God
