



Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE

2 Kings 2:1-15

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we looked at the story Elisha succeeding Elijah as the prophet to Israel. Elijah was taken up in the fiery chariot, and Elisha was left to continue God's work. Here are some of the main things we learned from the story in 2 Kings:

- Elisha was faithful to the call (2 Kings 2:1-6).
- Elisha was given power for the call (2 Kings 2:7-12).
- Elisha was equipped for the call (2 Kings 2:13-15).

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- How can we be faithful even when things get tough?
- What strengthens us to do what God wants us to do?
- When might you feel inadequate? Why is it important to know God will equip you to do what He wants you to do?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Some activities or tasks require certain equipment. From cooking to sports, having the right equipment is important. Set up a challenge with adequate and inadequate equipment. It could be related to cooking, cleaning, yard work, a game, and so on. Instruct your student to try the challenge with both sets of equipment. Then discuss how God wants to equip us by His Spirit to do what He has commanded us to do. God will give us all the power and wisdom we need for the tasks ahead of us.
